



Minor League Baseball Levels

Triple-A: Usually holds 15 MLB players from the 40 man MLB roster. Called “The Holding Cell”.

Double-A: Able to jump to the Majors. Top prospects.

Class A Advanced: Second or third promotion.

Class A: Mix of Short Season and Rookie players.

Class A-Short Season: Shortened season, from June to early September. Often first time using wooden bats.

Rookie: Lowest level. Shortened seasons.
